Event Overview

Eligibility

- Open to **high school** students (grades 9-12)
- One entry per student
- Student must attend a school in Saline County, Hot Spring County, Garland County or Grant County

Artwork Guidelines

- **2D** artwork **only** (no 3D/sculpture)
- Max size: **18" X 24" including mat**
- Acceptable mediums include drawing, painting, mixed media, digital art (must be printed for display)



DEADLINE

All entries must be submitted by February 6, 2026.

SUBMISSION PROCESS:

Drop off submissions at the main entrance of Saline Memorial Hospital from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays.

Judging & Awards

- Judge's Choice: \$100 Visa gift card for student
- People's Choice: \$100 Visa gift card for student
- Each winner's school will also receive a \$500 donation to the school's art program.

Exhibition & Voting

- The art show will be **Feb. 26 at 6:30 p.m.** in the hospital's education/administration building.
- Public voting for People's Choice ends at 7:10 p.m.
- Winners will announced at 7:20 p.m.
